



Thank you for registering for the 2nd annual, "5K Walk for Life" that will be held on Sunday, September 20, 2009 at Jack Johnson Field in Canal Winchester, OH. The "5K Walk for Life" is a fun event for the entire family. Last year over 350 walkers joined us on Jack Johnson Field for the inaugural Walk and this year you can expect to see familiar faces and make new friends as we lace up our shoes and take strides for life.

Here's what you need to know about the event:

- **Date:** Sunday, September 20, 2009
- **Place:** Jack Johnson Field, 4595 Gender Road, Canal Winchester
- **Schedule of Events:**
 - 1:00 pm: Registration & Walker Check-in
 - 1:45 pm: Kids' Fun Run
 - 2:00 pm: 5k Walk and Run

Now that you have registered as a walker and have a walker number, here's what we need you to do with the enclosed registration packet:

1. **Begin to get sponsors!** Set a goal for your fundraising efforts and start asking for support! Use the enclosed **sponsor pledge form** to recruit support from your friends, family, neighbors, and co-workers (be sure to invite them to walk with you as well!). Your supporters can either give a one-time donation to TWC or we'll send them an invoice so they can fulfill their pledge after the event. To encourage you, we're offering these LIFE SAVER Prizes:

On the day of the walk, bring the completed sponsor pledge form along with any donations you've received to date. Donations can be made by cash, check, credit card or invoice. All checks should be made payable to TWC.

2. Complete the enclosed **mail sponsorship list** and return it to TWC by Monday, September 1. Candidates for this list are the people you don't see often who are likely to support you and TWC – such as out-of-town friends, family and business associates. (People you're not having sponsor you on the "sponsorship pledge form".) We'll return the list to you with TWC letters and envelopes that you can personalize and then return to us and we'll mail them for you. This will increase your chances of earning the prizes above and helps us spread the good news about TWC far beyond your neighborhood.

Remember, if you're unable to be there on the morning of the walk, that's okay too...you can fax, mail, or even drop off the forms to TWC after the WALK and it still counts!

We have been thrilled at the community's response to The Women's Clinic of Columbus. Clearly, it fulfills a crucial need – it's a place that's meeting a need by caring for young girls and taking a stand for life. Thank you for helping us to make "Walk for Life" a success!
